

Short-term licence application

This form is used to apply for short-term licenses under the *Crown Land Management Act 2016*. Applications are to be submitted two months in advance of the commencement date.

A short-term license may be offered for a period of up to 12 months for any of the following prescribed purposes:

- access through a reserve
- advertising
- camping using a tent, caravan or otherwise
- catering and functions
- community, training or education
- emergency occupation
- entertainment
- environmental protection, conservation, restoration or environmental studies
- exhibitions
- filming (within the meaning of the *Local Government Act 1993*)
- markets and shows
- hiring of equipment
- holiday accommodation
- meetings
- military exercises
- mooring of boats to wharves or other structures
- sales
- site investigation
- sporting and organised recreational activities
- stabling of horses and equestrian events
- storage

Fee

An application fee of \$37.00 and one-off rental payment may be requested at the time of offer.

Where a short-term license is requested in order to provide significant community and/or environmental benefit, this fee and rent may be waived.

Intended purpose

Please describe the reason you are applying for this licence and the proposed purpose/use of Crown land.

Lake Conjola entrance has been in a state of closure since April 2019, on 15 December 2019 the lake level rose to 0.95m AHD. Under the Lake Conjola Interim Management Policy this level allowed Council to begin to excavate a pilot channel, with a view to opening the lake at 1.0m AHD. On 21 December Council attempted to open the lake, under this trigger given the increase in population predicted over the 2018/19 holiday period and further rainfall predicted. However, the lake closed within 48 hours, Council attempted a second opening but decided not to proceed given the risk of a fish kill and rotting marine vegetation, based on advice from DPI Fisheries.

On 5 February 2019 Council passed a resolution (see attached) to remove the sand plug from the pilot channel (see map for location details). Council applied for a short-term licence to occupy Crown Land for the purpose of excavating the "pilot channel and sand plug". This application was not supported by OEH or DPI Fisheries and it was determined that Council were not to proceed with opening the Lake and the licence was not granted (your reference 19/01371).



On 26 March 2019 Council passed a resolution (see attached) to make further representations to the relevant agencies for approval to open the entrance of Lake Conjola, specifically Item 1a - d in the resolution. Attached to this application are the following supporting documents: Lake Conjola Interim Entrance Management Policy, Review of Environmental Factors, resolution to make further representations to relevant agencies from 26 March and submission from the Lake Conjola Community Association regarding health/public risk associated with a closed lake condition.
