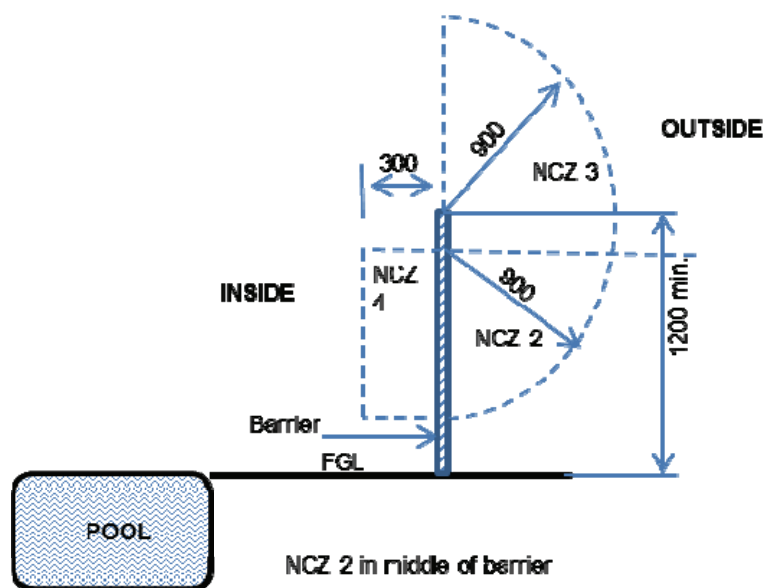
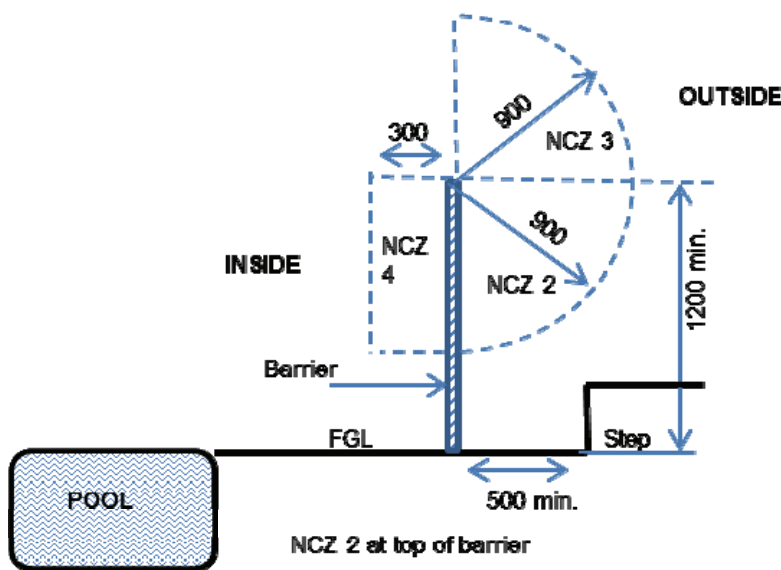


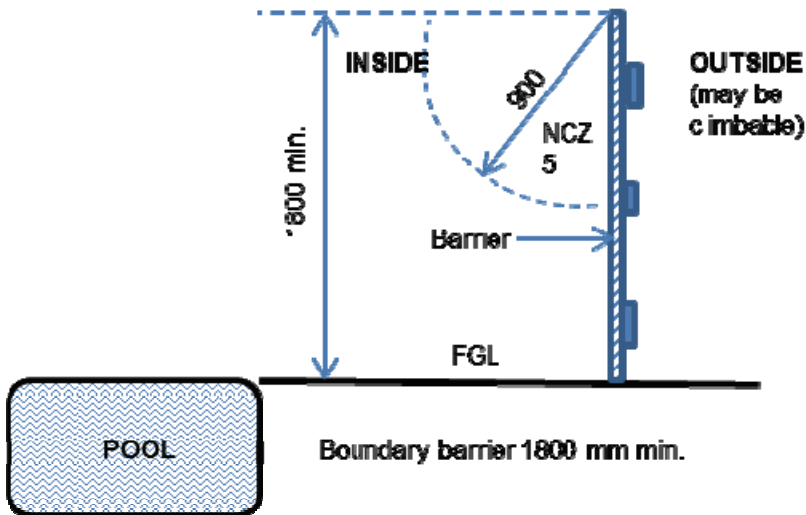
NON CLIMBABLE ZONES (NCZ) and BALCONY BARRIERS

The height and radius of the arc of all NCZs (other than NCZ 4) shall be not less than 900mm. Within a NCZ there shall be no handholds or footholds, objects or plants that will facilitate climbing.

Where NCZs are required they shall apply to the entire length of a barrier.

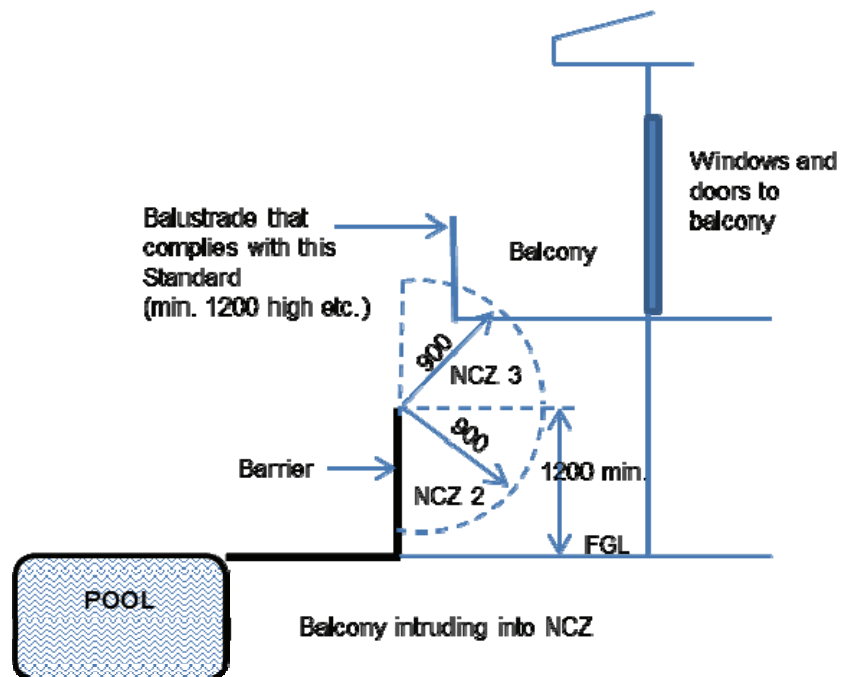
Boundary Fence Barrier



In addition to NCZs, steps, retaining walls, objects or level changes that would otherwise reduce the height of the barrier within a property shall not be located within 500mm of the barrier.

Balcony Balustrades

A balcony that protrudes into a NCZ shall be fitted with a balustrade that complies with the barrier requirements of AS1926.1-2012.
