

POOL DEMOLITION

If you intend to:

- Demolish or remove an existing swimming pool; or
- Change the use of an existing swimming pool to something else, eg. Fish pond

You require an approval before the work is carried out.

A Complying Development Certificate (CDC) or a Development Application (DA) may be submitted. The CDC or DA can be prepared by the local Council or a private certifier.

If the swimming pool or associated structure has heritage significance, consult the local Council.

You should advise Council of the pool removal to enable updating of the Swimming Pool Register and Council records.
