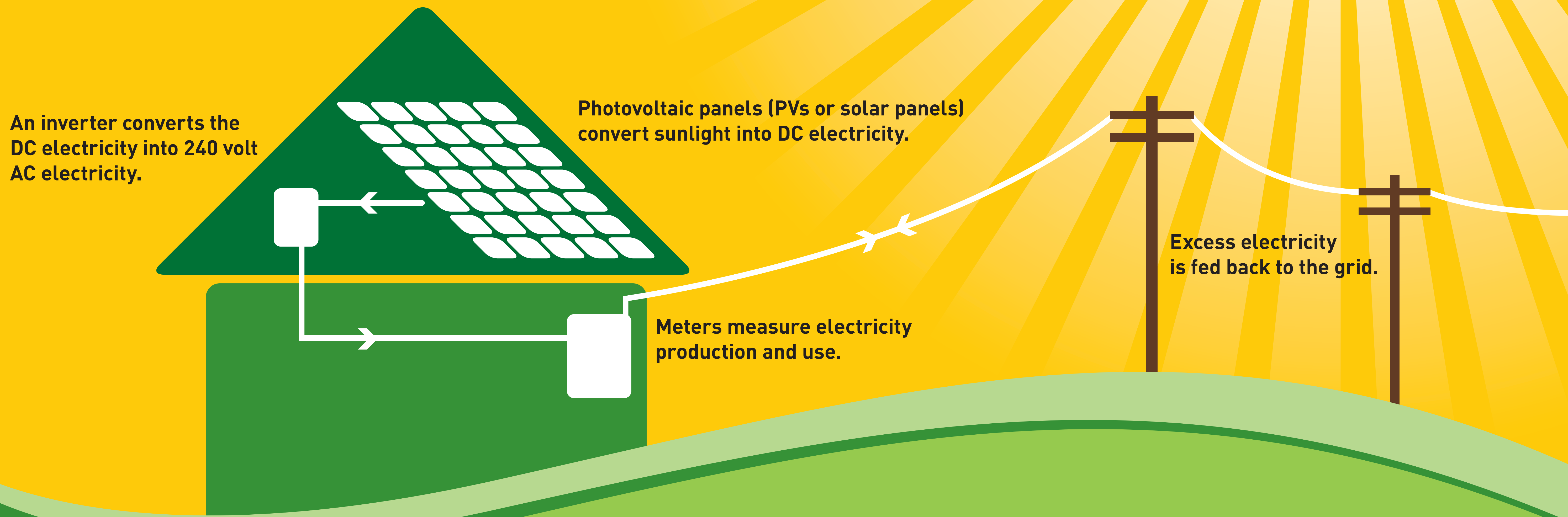


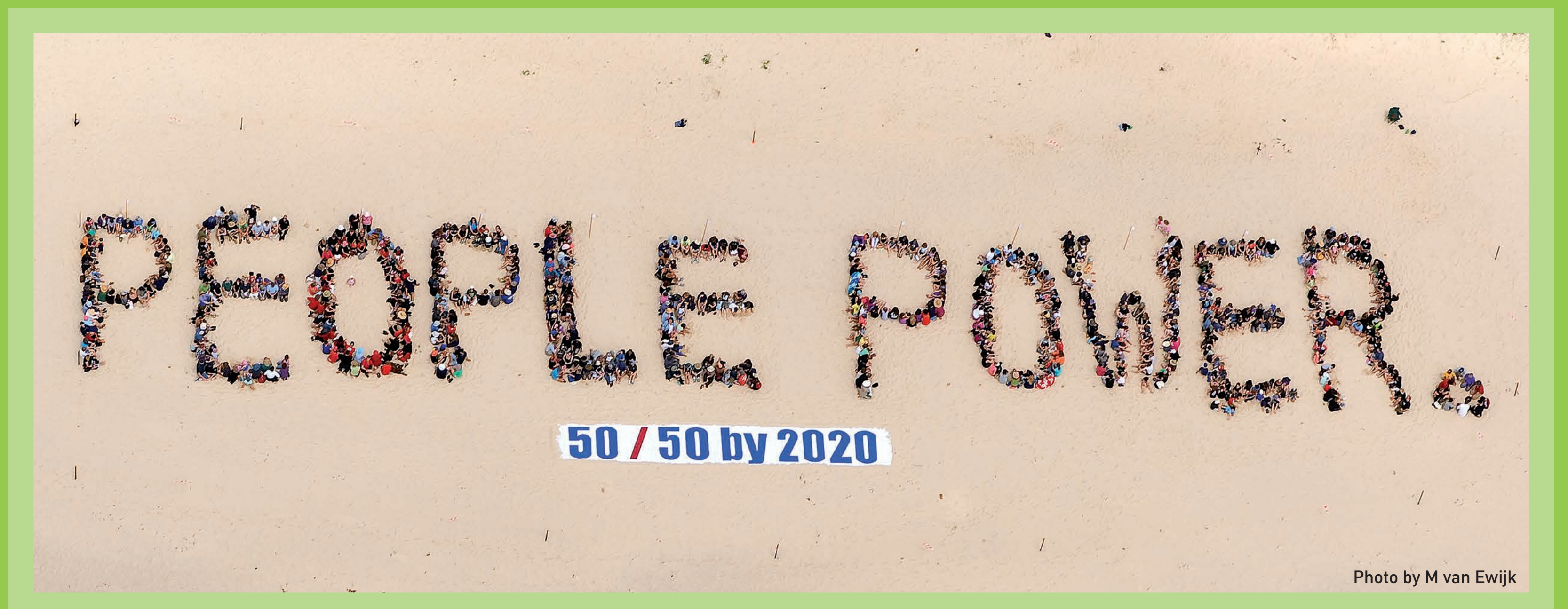
THIS BUILDING USES THE SUN

In December 2009 a 2 kilowatt (2kW) solar system was installed on this building. Local group Footprint sourced funds from the Bendigo Bank and Shoalhaven City Council. Barker Electrical provided the system at reduced cost and it was installed by Solar Energy Options for free.
