## Local Clubs Support the Shoalhaven Community

Clubs NSW Community Development Support Expenditure Scheme allows registered clubs with annual gaming machine revenue exceeding \$1 million to apply 1.5% of their gaming revenue to specific community Development and Support Projects.

Groups qualifying for Category 1 funding are Children, Youth, Women, People from Cultural & Linguistic Backgrounds, Older People, People with a Disability, Aboriginal and the general community.

A local CDSE Committee has been formed in the Shoalhaven Local Government area which identifies priorities for Category 1 and makes recommendations to local clubs. The local CDSE Committee comprises of representative/s of CDSE qualifying clubs, representative/s of Council, representative/s of DoCS, representative/s of NCOSS, or a major local or regional affiliate of NCOSS and representative/s of the local Aboriginal community where appropriate.

Shoalhaven City Council supports the CDSE Local committee in providing local area governance, providing local community service planning input, convening meetings of the CDSE Local Committee and undertakes all administration support to the committee.
