## Council calls for community help on Graffiti Action Day – Sunday May 15

Shoalhaven City Council has nominated 3 sites around the Shoalhaven for proposed action on NSW Graffiti Action Day and calls for community groups and individual volunteers on May 15 to make it happen.

**Proposed Site 1:**

Thurgate Oval, Bomaderry – repaint the brick wall



**Proposed Site 2:**

Wool Lane Sporting Complex, St Georges Basin – repaint the building



**Proposed Site 3:**

Francis Ryan Sportsfield, Sanctuary Point – paint wall and plant out area to discourage further graffiti.



**Proposed Site 4:**

A property fence along Island Point Rd between Grange Rd and the Highway (no image available)

Park Operations Manager Brett Carter says council are committed to the fight against graffiti. "Parks are proud to be a part of Graffiti Action Day" says Mr Carter. "We are happy to provide the plants and the materials, but we can't do it alone"

Calling communities to action Mr Carter said "We know the community hates seeing graffiti every day and now people have a chance to make a real difference."

"We need a commitment from individuals and community organisations to be there with us at 9am on Sunday May 15" Mr Carter said.
