New Public Amenities at Parkes Crescent Callala Beach

Shoalhaven City Council is pleased to announce the opening of a new public amenities building at Parkes Crescent, Callala beach in the reserve opposite the shops.

The public amenity will be open for the Easter school Holiday period.

The public amenity building is a single use unisex amenity suitable for use by all persons including those persons with disabilities.

Shoalhaven City Mayor Councillor Paul Green said the public amenity building is a wonderful asset for the town.

“Council also recognises and thanks the Callala Beach Progress Association who have been instrumental in gaining this facility for the area,” Clr Green said.

The public amenity was identified for construction from Councils Asset Management Plan (AMP) for Public Amenities.
