Works to replace sewer main

Shoalhaven Water is replacing a sewer main in River Road, Sussex Inlet. Works are expected to be completed by end of March.

Works include the replacement of a section of pipe on the bridge over Chris Creek. The new pipe replaces a corroded ductile iron pipe that is 30 metres long. The pipeline is a sewer rising main that transfers sewage to the Sussex Inlet treatment works.

Minor works to establish on site commenced last week with the pipeline replacement to be conducted on 8 and 9 March.

During construction, the contractors, Cadifern, will maintain vehicular access through the work zone. Traffic movements will be reduced to one lane across the bridge with traffic lights in place to control the traffic.

Council advises that there might be delays and all citizens are encouraged to allow for extra time for their travel.
