Call for designs for Ulladulla Civic Centre refurbishment

Shoalhaven City Council is currently advertising for architects and building designers to submit fee proposals to prepare concept plans for the refurbishment of the Ulladulla Civic Centre and design of a modern library.

Like all tenders and quotations considered by Council, companies intending to submit a bid for the redesign will be assessed on a number of selection criteria including prior experience in carrying out projects of a similar nature with regard to size, complexity and scope, technical skills of their staff involved in the job, their ability to deliver the project on time, value for money, and cost to Council.

Shoalhaven City Mayor Councillor Paul Green said: "A project steering panel involving community representatives will assist Council to oversee the design and delivery of the project and the appointed building designer will need to consider all the issues and suggestions raised by the community."

At this stage, it is planned that detailed concept plans will be available for community comment and review in July 2011 with construction beginning in 2012.

Council has budgeted \$5.5 Million for the project and potential designers will need to submit their fee proposals by 22 February 2011.
