Bomaderry Railway Station Awning Extension

A contract has been awarded to Nowra company Ablock Builders to extend the existing awning at Bomaderry Railway Station for additional users comfort. Grant funding of \$206,300 was secured from the NSW Government through the Country Passenger Transport Infrastructure Scheme to improve passenger facilities at the interchange. The delivery of the improvements is being managed by Council's Project Delivery Section. To minimise disruption to passengers the works have been staged. The first stage of additional shelters for bus and taxi passengers was recently completed by Council staff. The second stage of the awning extension will commence in late June and will take approximately 12 weeks to complete.

Ablock Builders site manager Pat Donnelly said "We are doing as much prefabrication off site as possible to minimise disruption to passengers, buses, cars and taxis coming and going from early to late. There will be some access changes during the work, however these will be as small as possible and will include ramps to assist passengers"
