The outdoor 50 metre and indoor 25 metre swimming pools at Bomaderry Aquatic Centre will be closed to the public on Saturday and Sunday, 11 & 12 December 2010 to host the South Eastern Swimming Association (SESA) Carnival.

Two (2) lanes in the indoor 25 metre pool will still be available for the running of normal Learn to Swim and other Programs on Saturday morning. After 12.30pm, both indoor and outdoor pools will be closed for the exclusive use of the SESA Carnival.

The carnival will attract visitors to the Shoalhaven and will feature some great racing events for both competitors and spectators to enjoy.

Carnivals are a great way to feature the Shoalhaven facilities and encourage interest in the sport of swimming.

This event will include clubs from the Illawarra in the north to Eden on the Far South Coast, extending up to Cooma and Jindabyne in the Snowy Mountains, and inland to Bowral and Bundanoon.

Council's Nowra Olympic Pool and village and sea pools located at Kangaroo Valley, Berry, Shoalhaven Heads, Greenwell Point and Huskisson will remain open to the public as usual on this weekend.
