Holiday Haven and TAFE to sign MOU

Councils Holiday Haven Tourist Parks and the Illawarra Institute of TAFE are set to sign a Memorandum of Understanding in regard to the construction of ensuites and other small amenities units for Council's Tourist Parks.

After Holiday Haven staff constructed a prototype ensuite unit 7 years ago, they raised the opportunity with TAFE for producing further units based on the initial design.

Since then TAFE have been building ensuite units for Holiday Haven for the past six years with significant design variations developed by park management teams, Holiday Haven staff and TAFE Building & Construction staff.

The MOU is an understanding to lay out the grounds for TAFE students to have some units to build over the course of the educational year.

The units will be worked on by a range of classes at various levels undertaking the full range of building tasks. Each ensuite is like a small house in that it combines framing & cladding, lighting & electrical, plumbing, tiling, painting etc.

The MOU is not a binding contract just a formalisation of the working relationship held between TAFE and Shoalhaven Council in the past.

Holiday Haven Tourist Parks manager Kevin Sullivan is pleased to be formalising the arrangement with TAFE.

"TAFE and Holiday Haven have had an excellent partnership for many years. This document will build on the existing strengths and collaborative activities of our two organisations." he said.
