Hours of operation for sea pools

Next week the Huskisson and Ulladulla Sea pools will open for the Summer period.

The pools will remain open between November the 1st 2010 and April 25th 2011, closing at the end of the Easter School Holidays.

Hours of opening are

November 1st 2010 to February 28th 2011 - 6am til 6pm

March 1st 2011 to April 25th 2011- 7 am til 6pm

The sea pools will be closed for cleaning one (1) day per week. The Ulladulla Sea Pool will be closed on a Tuesday each week during the season for cleaning and the Huskisson Sea Pool and wading pool will be closed each Thursday during the season for cleaning.

Shoalhaven City Mayor, Clr Paul Green said the location of the both seapools is a real drawcard for locals and visitors alike.

“The views of Jervis Bay from the Huskisson Pool and the Harbourside from the Ulladulla pool are simply stunning and offer an alternative to beach swimming whilst still being close to nature.”

No entry fees apply at the sea pools. Each pool will be inspected daily by Council staff prior to opening.

No lifeguard service will be provided at the Huskisson Sea Pool or wading pool or the Ulladulla Sea Pool. The pools will be unsupervised throughout the season.

Patrons are responsible for their own safety when using the sea pools and parents are responsible for the safety of children in and around the pool areas.
