Swan Lake Public Amenities Open for Use

A new public amenities building has recently been opened at Swan Lake boat ramp (off Springs Road between Cudmirrah and Berrara).

This building caters for the growing demand of people engaging in activities around the lake and boat ramp area.

Shoalhaven City Mayor Councillor Paul Green said the public amenities building is a wonderful asset for an area that attracts many users during the summer months.

“Council recognises and thanks the Cudmirrah Berrara Swanhaven Progress Association, Sussex Inlet Community Forum and the Sussex Inlet Chamber of Commerce Inc who have been instrumental in gaining this facility for the area,” Clr Green said. “These dedicated groups have also been involved in the Cudmirrah to Berrara cycleway project”.

The location and design was chosen after community consultation, and considered environmental issues, visibility to passing motorists, maintaining the vista, and the close proximity for boat users.

The \$80k construction of the public amenities was identified in Council’s Asset Management Plan for Public Amenities.

It has been co-ordinated by Council’s Facilities & Asset Management Unit with Councils Northern Building Maintenance crew completing the construction and Shoalhaven Water providing the water connection.
