Community input sought - Conjola Lake Floodplain Risk Management Study and Plan

Council is seeking the community's input in the development of a Floodplain Risk Management Study and Plan for Conjola Lake.

The project is being conducted on behalf of Shoalhaven City Council by a team of consultants specialising in floodplain management.

The Study will look at various options to reduce the risks and damages caused by flooding in the Conjola Lake catchment.

The Study's recommendations will be brought together in the Conjola Lake Floodplain Risk Management Study and Plan which will guide Council in managing the flood prone lands now and into the future.

Landowners, residents and businesses are invited to participate in the Study by expressing their views and providing comment on flooding issues throughout the course of the Study.

A public information session will be held on Wednesday 20 October 2010 from 3:30pm to 6:30pm at the Lake Conjola Community Centre, Lake Conjola Entrance Road, Lake Conjola.
