Road works for Murramarang Road

Shoalhaven City Council will be undertaking road rehabilitation works on two sections of Murramarang Road, Bawley Point, over the next four months.

Works valued at about \$340,000 will be carried out between Shearwater Crescent and Binnowie Place to the north and between Malibu Drive and Voyager Crescent to the south on Murramarang Road.

Minor works to establish the sites will begin this week and this will be followed shortly with the road rehabilitation works. The works are due for completion at the end of October 2010.

The works will include the reconstruction and upgrade of the existing roadway, including widening of the road and sealing of the shoulders for both sections of works.

The northern section will also gain an extra parking lane, kerb and gutter, improved stormwater drainage and a two-metre wide shared path along the eastern side of the road.

During construction, the contractors ELH Road & Bridge Construction will maintain vehicular access to private properties and through the work zone.
