Kinghorne Street update

Revitalisation works on Kinghorne Street Nowra has uncovered old fuel tanks from service stations that were in operation during the mid 1900s. These old fuel tanks are being investigated by an environmental consultant who has advised a suitable remediation method, which Council is now pursuing.

The footpath works will continue but there will be a small delay while remediation works are undertaken on the old fuel tanks.

The work on Kinghorne Street has been completed on the southern side of Junction Street and has now moved to the area from Junction Street to North Street.

While the project is underway access to all businesses will remain during all stages of construction and where possible customers should use the rear access or access via O'Keefe Avenue.

Council expects the entire footpath revitalisation to be completed by the end of August 2010.
