## Shoalhaven Building Design Awards

The prestigious 2010 Shoalhaven Building Design Awards are now open and Council is calling for entries, with submissions closing on 30 July 2010.

The biennial awards are held to encourage and reward excellence in design across several categories and have been running since 1997 to foster and encourage the best development across the City. The Awards recognise the finest examples of creative design and quality construction throughout the Shoalhaven.

Closing date for submissions for the prestigious 2010 Shoalhaven Building Design Awards is 30 July 2010, with the awards to be presented on 15 October.

Shoalhaven City Council, which coordinates the awards, is seeking excellent designs in 11 categories.

The awards are held every two years and are open to all projects that are situated within Shoalhaven City and completed within the three years before the call for nominations.

The 2010 Shoalhaven Building Design Awards cover residential and commercial / industrial designs and entries will be judged in the following categories:

- Individual House to \$400,000 project cost
- Individual House above \$400,000 project cost
- Alterations & Additions to \$250,000 project cost
- Alterations & Additions above \$250,000 project cost
- Medium Density (including Dual Occupancy)
- Heritage Conservation
- Best practice in Building Sustainability
- Commercial/Industrial
- Tourist Development
- Subdivision Design
- Excellent access to Business Premises
