Kinghorne Street update

Construction of the streetscape in Kinghorne Street is continuing towards Junction Court.

Footpath construction outside the River Deli café, Raine and Horne Real Estate, and Block Buster Video is nearing completion with paving complete and a few street items, such as trees, tree guards and garbage bins to be placed.

Revitalisation works will now move outside Knickerbockers and Leading Edge video as the work moves towards Junction Street. Work on this area is expected to be completed by the end of May.

Access to all businesses will remain during all stages of the construction, which was timed to take place during colder months and out of holiday periods.

Following completion of that section of Kinghorne Street, work will move to the other side of Junction Court, moving down towards the Aldi supermarket.
