Kinghorne Street update

Construction on the new footpath is progressing steadily along Kinghorne Street, Nowra, with the work in Smith's Lane and Kinghorne Street corner nearly complete. Trees will soon be installed at the corner providing summer shade to shoppers.

The demolition work will progress northward in stages of approximately four shopfronts at a time and to accelerate the progress work will be carried out at both night and day.

There will be temporary impacts on car parking within the construction zone and front door access will be provided to all shops. All businesses adjacent to the construction work will be open and operating as usual.

When completed the new streetscape revitalise the CBD precinct giving the eastern side of Kinghorne Street a much needed facelift. The entire project is expected to be completed in August.
