## Council moves on waste services tender

A rescission motion for a waste services tender for Shoalhaven City was lost at an extraordinary meeting of Shoalhaven City Council on Friday 26 March 2010.

The original resolution of Council on Tuesday 23 March is now Council's resolution. At its meeting on 23 March Council resolved to accept tenders for the on call organics and bulky waste pick up, the weighbridge and non weighbridge operations of a new waste tender. Council had also resolved to not accept tenders which deal with the tendered three bin system for waste collection and processing.

Staff have been asked to report on a proposal to invite tenders for the continuation of its current two bin collection and processing system based on a contract term of six years with an option for extension for a period of 3 years and to adopt a series of supporting initiatives to improve waste management in the city.

This recommendation was halted following a rescission motion on this item from Council's meeting of 23 March.
