## Council gains \$1 million for Sanctuary Point road works

Shoalhaven City Council will receive a \$1 million interest-free loan from the NSW Local Infrastructure Fund to bring forward road works in Anson St, Sanctuary Point.

The work involves extending the existing section of Anson St by 350 metres to connect onto Island Point Road. This will also allow a start to be made on a new service road behind the St Georges Basin commercial area.

Council has already committed about \$800,000 of its funds to drainage works, which are currently being constructed in the area, and the loan will now allow the road works to proceed.

Shoalhaven City Mayor Councillor Paul Green welcomed the funding from the NSW government.

"These works will provide an impetus for both commercial and residential development to begin in the area," Cllr Green said. "This will help provide a great economic stimulus to the area during and after construction."

Construction works are expected to begin in April and to be completed by the end of 2010.

"The extension of Anson St will provide a significant boost to the local community by opening up land for development, which will ultimately improve amenity and employment opportunities," said Cllr Green.
