Culburra supermarket increases parking spaces

At its ordinary meeting of on April 13th, council resolved to accept the amended Voluntary Planning Agreement that includes an increase in parking spaces at the new commercial development site in Weston Street, Culburra Beach.

Council supported in part the approval for development of a supermarket, 6 retail shops car parking for 109 vehicles, signage, alterations to existing traffic works, landscaping, engineering and draining works.

Since that consent, the land was sold and the new owners prepared an application under section 96 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act with amendments. These amendments were to increase car parking spaces from 74 to 82 as a result of an increase in retail floor area.

Council will exhibit the amended VPA along with explanatory note for 28 days.

Shoalhaven City Mayor, Clr. Paul Green says the increase of parking spaces is a 'minor matter that is a result of an overall increase of retail space. The supermarket has already been approved and we are keen to see this project move forward so Culburra Beach can continue to become a vibrant shopping environment that will offer further retail choices to residents and visitors of the town.'

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
