Rauch Park to receive minor improvements

Rauch Park in Nowra will soon be provided with an additional entrance off Junction Street. The new entrance will enable easier access to the site and provide an alternative to using the existing steps into the park.

Improvements include:

- Relocating a 3 metre long section of the sandstone retaining wall fronting Junction Street, at the western end.
- Construction of a new graded access into the park
- Installation of bollards to outline the western boundary and restrict vehicle access in order to preserve the park
- Improvements to the signage within the park

Expected to commence during July, the new access will allow service vehicles direct entry to the site. It will also allow easier access for ceremonies held at the historic monument, erected in memory of those who fought in the Boer War.
