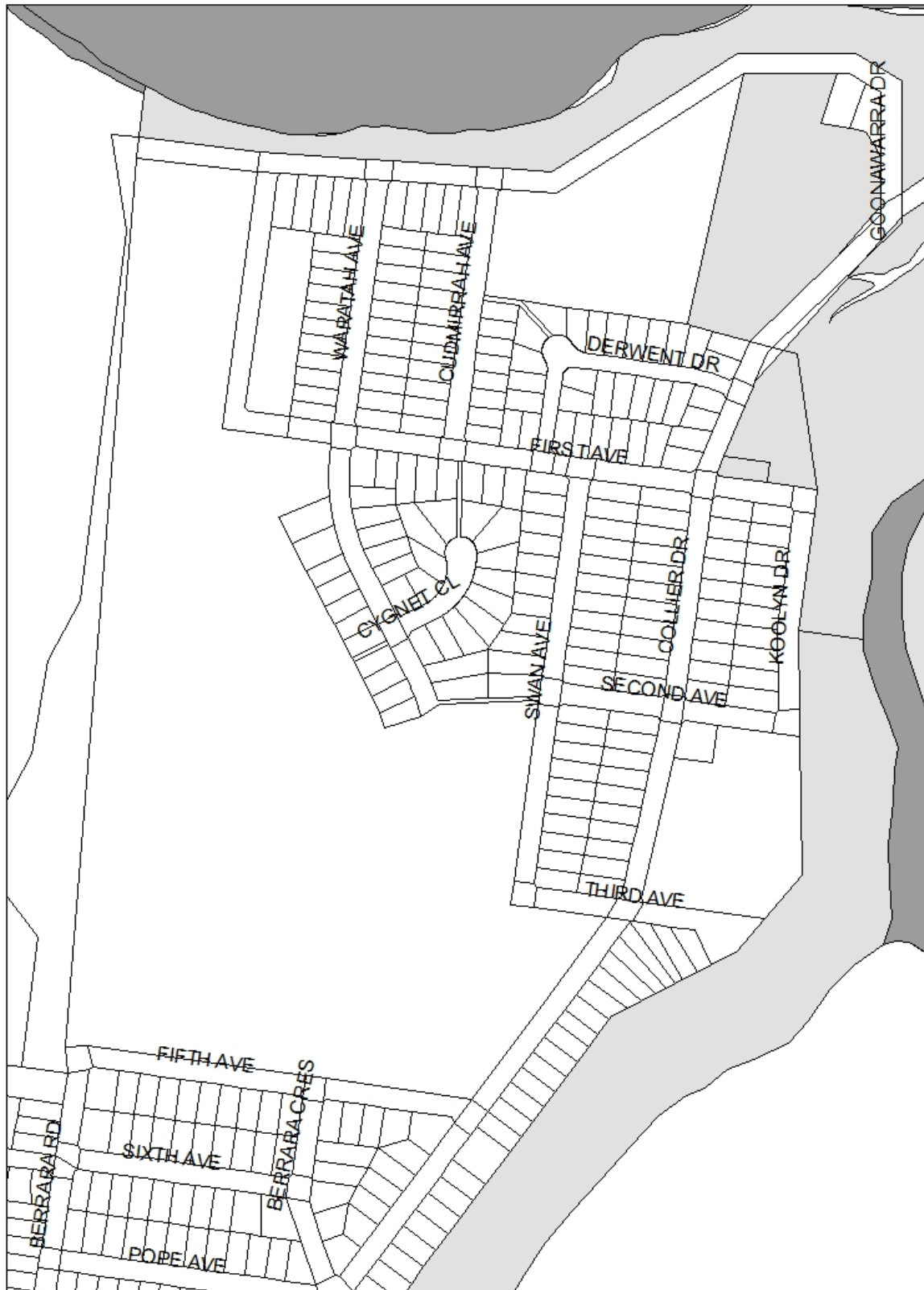
Reduce the rabbit population in the Cudmirrah locality.
