  - # Craig Milburn gave an update on the Shoalhaven Indoor Sports Centre and provided a PowerPoint presentation.

James Harris spoke to the Sporting Projects Status Update Report.

David Goodman advised that the Inaugural National Indigenous Football Championships will be held from 3 to 5 November 2016 at the South Nowra Sporting Complex.

Keith Wallace, NSW Sport and Recreation provided an update.

Craig Milburn provided an update on the international sailing regatta held in February, which included racing specifically for sailors with an intellectual disability.

The Committee discussed accessible toilet facilities and Mr Milburn advised that Sailability are able to provide portable accessible toilets for events until a more permanent arrangement can be made.

3. Additional Item – Shipping Containers used at Sporting Grounds

The issue of sporting clubs being charged an annual licence fee of \$518 to use shipping containers for club storage at sporting grounds was raised. Mr Milburn noted that Council is working with clubs regarding the concept of container use and the Property Unit is developing a standard agreement. It will be recommended to Council to waive these fees.

4. Additional Item – Heating for Sporting Club Change Rooms

File 4538E

The issue of water heating for sporting club change rooms was raised, for example, recently at Vincentia oval, the visiting teams could not shower because gas had run out. It was suggested that this may also be an issue for other clubs.

James Harris spoke about on-demand heating systems and advised that all options are being considered and the preferred option is gas.

The formal part of the meeting concluded at 6.16 pm and the Committee moved into a workshop to discuss the review of fees and charges.

#### **Shoalhaven Sports Board Review**

Upon the Board considering a report and final findings of the Sports Board Review, the Board recommended to Council that:

- b) A workshop be scheduled, as soon as convenient, with a majority of members of the Shoalhaven Sports Board, to discuss the recommendation contained in the Shoalhaven Sports Board Review report with a view to adopting those deemed appropriate

#### Report from the Department of Sport and Recreation

The Department of Sport and Recreation staff in attendance at this meeting are invited to provide a verbal report to the meeting.

#### **Shoalhaven Indoor Multipurpose Sporting Centre**

Construction of the Sports Centre is pending development approval consideration from the Joint Regional Planning Panel and construction of the Centre is anticipated to commence midyear. Sporting Association Stakeholders participated in a 90% design review and comments workshop on 30 March 2016. A Safety in Design Workshop was also held on 30 March 2016 with professional staff, architects, builders and project management.

#### **Bomaderry Regional Sporting & Community Hub Master Plan Investigations**

Public exhibition of a draft Master Plan is pending Council endorsement which is anticipated to be considered by Council in May. The Master Plan will be presented at this Sports Board meeting.

# **Bay & Basin Community Hub Master Plan**

Development of a draft Master Plan is currently undertaking stakeholder consultation with key interest groups and wider community input will be encouraged through public exhibition of the document. A draft Master Plan will be presented to an upcoming Sports Board meeting.

#### **Shoalhaven Equestrian Centre of Excellence**

Tenders have been endorsed by Council for Stage 1 development to commence following DA approval. On ground works are anticipated to commence in August 2016.

Consultants have been appointed for Financial & Business modelling of the adopted site Master Plan including Stage 2. Further information will be provided to the Board once this is completed.

#### **Berry District Park Master Plan**

The Master Plan has been endorsed by Council and includes a cycling complex. Implementation of the Plan is pending future funding from Council, grant programs and/or in-kind community group support.

#### South Nowra Soccer Fields Amenities Building

The design of the replacement South Nowra Soccer Fields Amenities is now being finalised for tender advertisement. The building has been co funded by the Shoalhaven Soccer Association.

#### Fees & Charges review

Council's fees & charges review being undertaken by LKS Quaero (who presented at the last Sports Board meeting) continues.

#### **Draft Community Infrastructure Strategic Plan**

Council has endorsed public exhibition of the draft Community Infrastructure Strategic Plan. Sports Board members are encouraged to view, provide feedback and encourage community feedback related to the draft Plan. #### Non-Motorised Watersports Master Plan – Parringa Park

Council has been working with the non-motorised water sports user groups to develop a facility at Paringa Park, The facility is to provide a multipurpose space for sailing, water dragons, sea scouts, rowing to:- meet, provide storage along with redesign of foreshore to allow for parking and launching facilities. The concept plans have been presented to the user groups and Council is currently requesting funds from Council (May report) to progress this project to detail design so that the project is 'shovel ready' and grant funding can be sought.
