- A person will be in necessitous circumstances where his or her financial resources are insufficient to obtain all that is necessary, not only for a bare existence, but for a modest standard of living in the Australian community.
- Necessitous circumstances may result from a disaster caused by flood, fire, drought, tempest or other calamity.

Delegated Authority

The management of the fund is vested in the Shoalhaven City Mayor's Relief Fund Committee. Rules have been adopted by Council.

Staff provided a report on the August Floods as follows:

- Since the floods Council has received 23 calls for assistance from residents, 1 being a business
- Out of the 23, 6 have been contacted requesting relief funding, most coming from the Sanctuary Point/St Georges Basin and Sussex Inlet areas
- Council has applied for a Natural Disaster Zone and is yet to be confirmed.
- Council has setup an online link for Donations
- To date Council has donated \$565 in way of relief funding
- Reports were received that 70 dwellings had been impacted by water inundation
