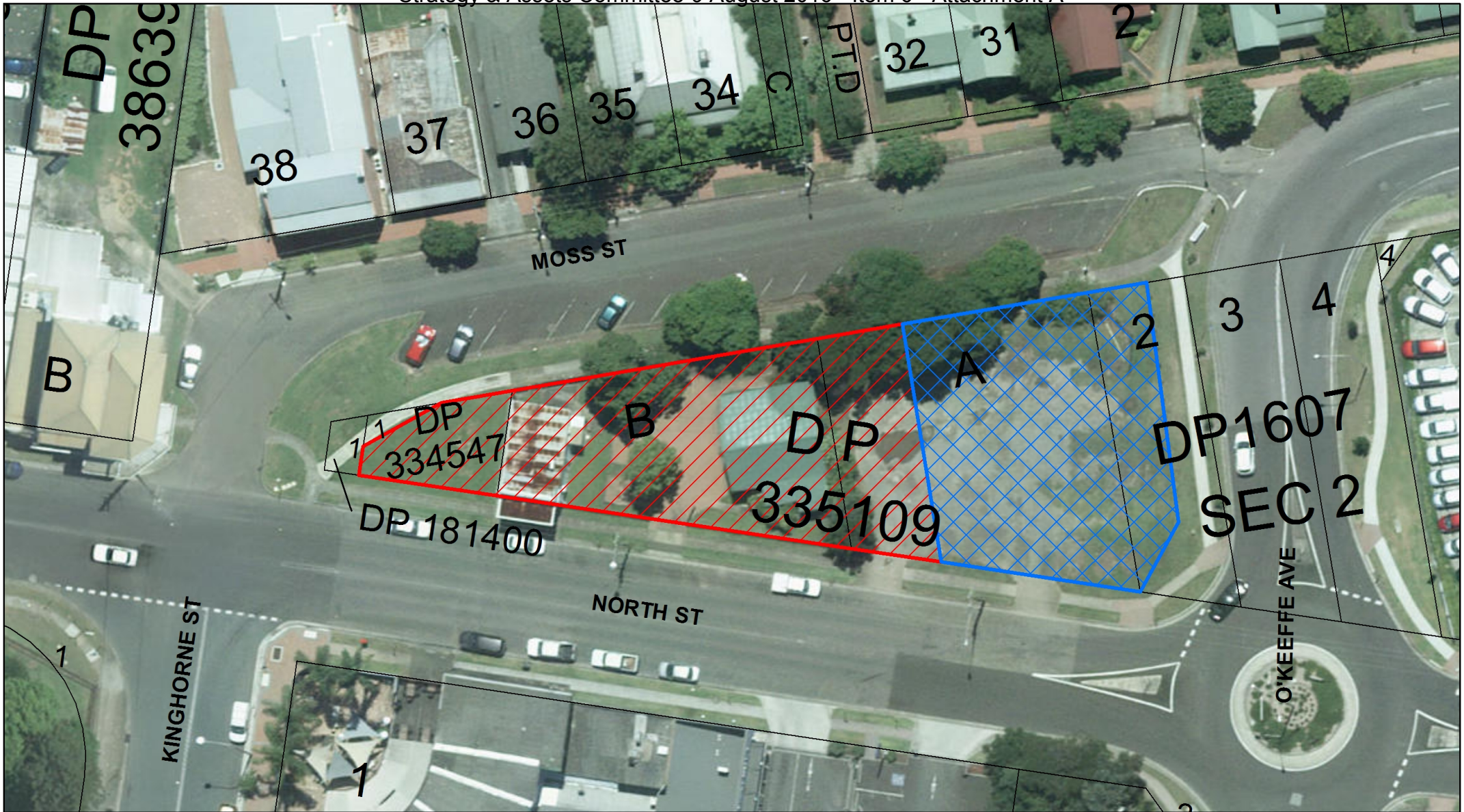

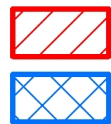

over Lot A DP 335109 & Part Lot 2 DP 1607 Sec 2**

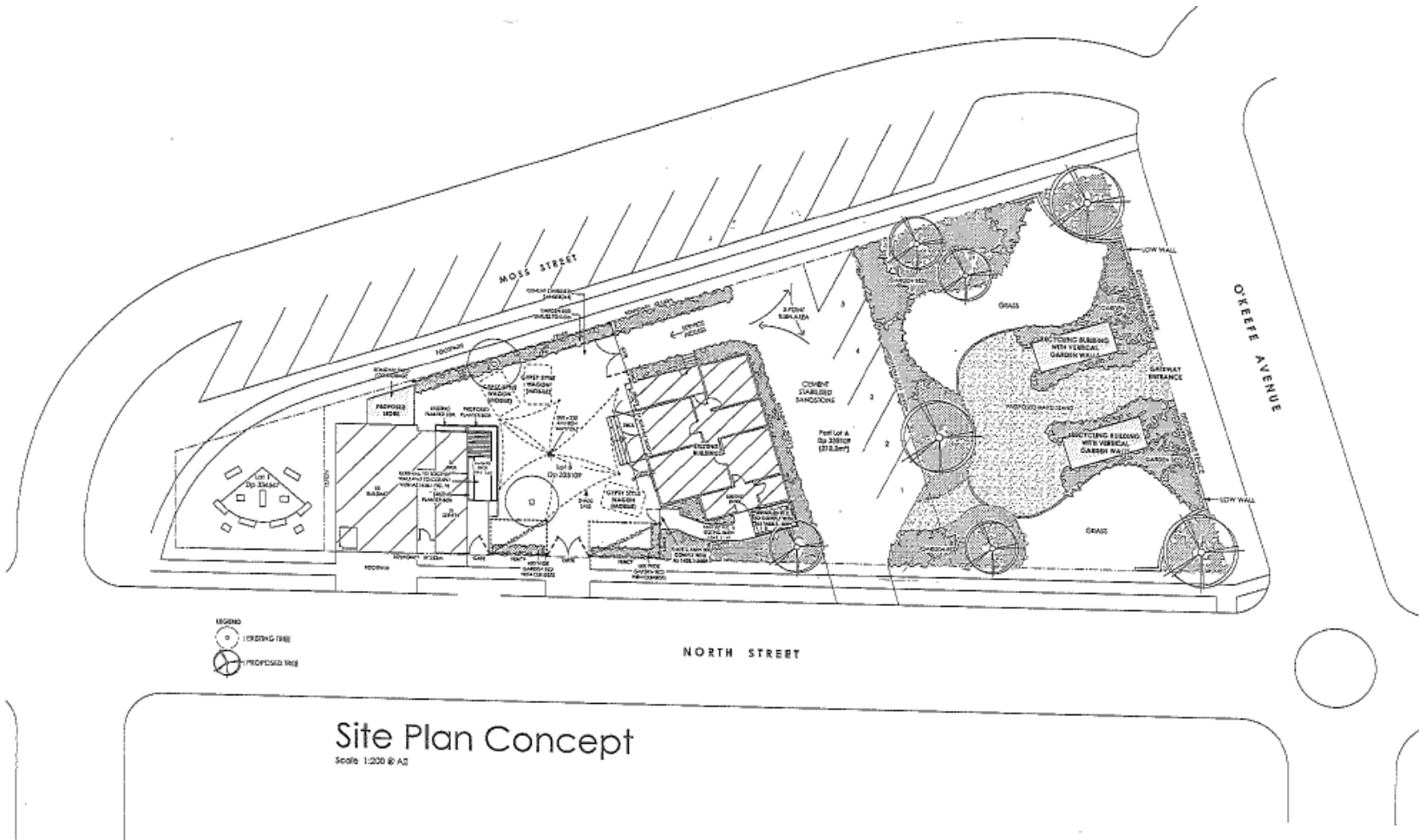


Lease Area to Hyper Hyper

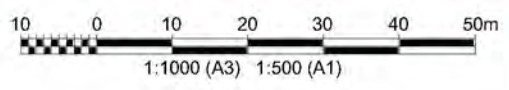
