Schofields Lane to Pumpkin Patch

17.2.16 – GoVita corner of Schofields Lane and Kinghorne St

- 9-11am = Excavation work, steel cutting and fixing for formwork for new concrete works
- 11-12pm = Concrete pour of footings around garden bed
- 12-3.30pm = Excavation work by machine and hand around Optic Fibre, NBN & high pressure gas.

18.2.16 - GoVita

- 7-7:30am = sawcut bitumen to allow for new K&G
- 7:30 – 8:30am = excavator to cut out bitumen
- 9am = move excavator between GoVita & Nowra Sports Store

19.2.16 - GoVita – Nowra Sports Store

- Excavation by hand and machine in day time around Optic Fibre, NBN & high pressure gas.
- Place tree pits

20.2.16 – Cnr Schofields Lane & Kinghorne St in front of GoVita

- Bricklaying on new footings to create garden bed edging.

- Worrigee Street (northern side) between Kinghorne Street and Berry Street
- Kinghorne Street (western side) between Egans Lane and North Street
- North Street (both sides) between Berry Street and Princes Highway
- Schofields Lane
- O'Keeffe Avenue (both sides) between Junction Street and North Street
- Berry Street (western side) between Worrigee Street and Junction Street
- Berry Street (both sides) pedestrian crossover and footpath upgrade to Post Office corner Junction Street
