



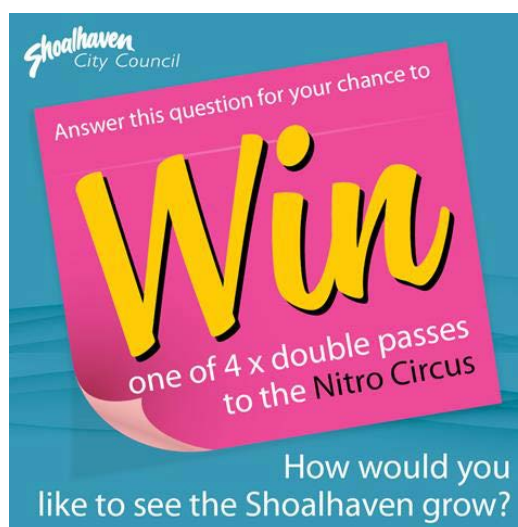

"Stage 2 is scheduled for July - September 2017 and includes completing the fitness gym area,

New recreational skate park for Culburra

The Culburra Beach Community Project Committee are celebrating a major milestone with the first turning of the soil to build a new recreational community skate park at Curley's Bay Reserve.

"We received the green light from Shoalhaven City Council to manage the park project at the community level and have moved quickly to get Stage 1 of the Curley's Bay Recreational Skate Park facility built," said Alex McNeilly, Project Manager

Through a collaborative approach and by working directly with our local, state and federal government plus lots of community fundraising, donations and in-kind support we hope to complete the entire Curley's Bay Recreational Park at Culburra Beach before Christmas." said Alex.



Roads and Works Update

Winnima Lane, Huskisson – Pavement and shoulder sealing adjacent to the new kerb and gutter construction at Nowra Street and Beach Streets are scheduled to be completed at the end of March.

Currarong Road, Kinghorne - Council has engaged a contractor to undertake full pavement rehabilitation on Currarong Road for approximately 500m as well as approximately 3500sqm of heavy patching in close proximity to this site.

Stewart Place, Nowra – The new entrance/exit to the carpark is now open. Further work will be

Matron Porter Drive, Milton – Shared User Path Stage 3 from Frogs Holla Sports Grounds to Sungrove Lane (425m - 2.5m wide) is in progress.

Quinns Lane and Old Southern Road Intersection, South Nowra - Works are progressing on the roundabout construction at the Quinns Lane and Old Southern Road intersection. Wet weather and service relocation works will delay completion of the project until April. Centre island works are planned over the coming weeks that will allow the intersection to start working as a roundabout.

South Street and Jubilee Avenue, Ulladulla - Council is constructing a new roundabout at the intersection of South Street and Jubilee Ave, incorporating a new entrance to the adjoining carpark. The roadworks have begun and will continue to late May (weather permitting) during which time South Street, Jubilee Avenue and the adjoining carpark access will be closed at the work site.

Park Road and John Purcell Way, Nowra - An asphalt program will commence on 10 April 2017. Weather permitting, this work will be completed by 11 April 2017. Detours will be in place during the work.

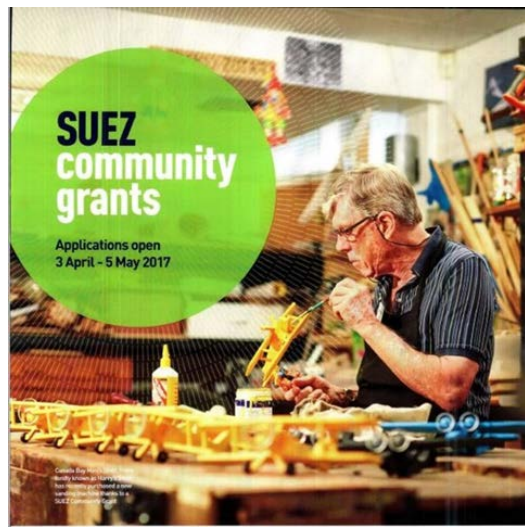
