Shoalhaven Water's Shane Kimber has won the Water Industry Operators Association's (WIOA) prestigious individual "NSW Operator of the Year" award. Congratulations.

Shane is the Operator at Shoalhaven Water's sewage treatment plant at Callala which includes the Reclaimed Effluent Management Scheme. This scheme provides recycled water to several farms from a 600 ML dam at the Callala Sewerage Treatment Plant.



Shane runs all public tours including open days, and department training courses and continually receives great feedback on the way tours are conducted.

Shane has a few unspoken guidelines which have proven to be beneficial in daily operations, "Keep it simple, put it away today, be adaptable, nothing is too hard, ask for help, cleanliness is easy, tomorrow is another day and respect goes both ways".


### Commonwealth must honour its promise to Shoalhaven City Council community
