Roads and Works Update

Conjola - Lake Conjola Entrance Road -

Roadworks are continuing. During the works Havilland Street will be temporarily closed to traffic and Conjola Park access will be restricted to Kurrajong Crescent.

Nowra - Meroo Road - Road rehabilitation works are scheduled to be undertaken from the middle of May 2017. The works consist of deep lift asphalt and wearing course replacement at the intersections of Samuel St, Edward Ave, Concorde Way and McIntyre Way. These works will be carried out under partial road closures, resident access will be maintained at all times.

Worrigee Street - Construction is expected to start in May. Parking may be affected during this time.

Ulladulla - South Street and Jubilee Avenue -

Works are recommencing on the roundabout. The work site will be again closed at which time South Street, Jubilee Avenue and the adjoining carpark access will be closed at the work site. Note that the Burrill Street South carpark entrance has been modified to allow better access during the works. Current completion date is late June.



Sussex Inlet - *Sussex Inlet Road* - Road works are scheduled to be undertaken adjacent to 802 Sussex Inlet Road from 8 May to 2 June 2017. Works will be undertaken to raise the level of the existing pavement, in preparation of the construction of a new culvert.

Vincentia - *Dacres Street* – Drainage upgrade works incorporating minor sections of new kerb and gutter will commence in May.

Road and assets projects are regularly updated on the Council website.

Shoalhaven City Council is undertaking a review of the residential zoned area to the West and South West of the Nowra CBD. The review will include a workshop and will look at how recent medium density developments have and could continue to impact on or influence the character of the area.
