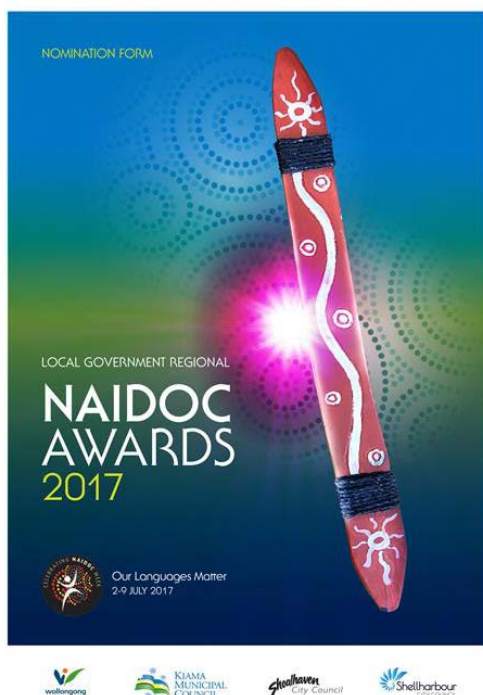

Growing our future

Did you know that Council's bushcare program runs a community nursery? This nursery supplies local native species for environmental works and rehabilitation projects in Council managed reserves.

The nursery bushcare group meets every last Sunday of the month 9am-12pm to propagate native plants. The nursery grows up to 5000 plants per year and is not commercial enterprise.

The nursery also runs native plant propagation workshops for community groups, Schools, TAFE, Green Army and is also willing to donate plants to not-for-profit community groups where possible.

Native plants are given away at selected community events throughout the year to encourage people to grow native plants in their garden to attract native birds and animals and raise awareness of native species amongst residents.

The nursery is located at Culburra Beach at the northern roundabout on Prince Edward Ave – Next door to the Marine Rescue Centre towards Crookhaven Headland.

10 - 12 June - Shoalhaven Coast Winter Wine Festival.
