### Cleaning up this long weekend?

Council will be hosting free Household Chemical CleanOuts next weekend. These provide a safe way to dispose of potentially hazardous household chemicals. If not disposed of correctly, chemicals can cause harm to human health and the environment.

Collection is for domestic sourced materials only and is limited to 20 litres or 20 kilograms per person.

Materials suitable for disposal include acids, alkalis, batteries, fire extinguishers, fuels, fertilisers, gas bottles, herbicides, paints, pesticides, poisons, pool chemicals oven and household cleaners, solvents and any unknown chemicals you may have. Fluorescent light tubes are suitable to be disposed of via this service.

Domestic quantities of motor oil can be taken to any of Council's 10 Recycling & Waste Depots, at no charge, any time of the year.

## Bendalong Masterplan

Council is seeking public comment on a draft masterplan that has been prepared for the small beach and adjacent reserves known as Boat Harbour, at Bendalong.

Council has prepared a masterplan for the area due to an array of challenges in the constrained site, including conflicts in use and impacts from the neighbouring Holiday Haven Bendalong Point Tourist Park.
