Bendalong Boat Harbour Masterplan

Council is seeking public comment on a





draft masterplan covering the small beach and adjacent reserves known as Boat Harbour at Bendalong.

Council has prepared a masterplan for this area due to conflicts in use, impacts from the neighbouring Holiday Haven Bendalong Point Holiday Park and a multiplicity of issues in the very constrained site.

Four draft plans have been prepared detailing proposed actions for the whole of Boat Harbour as well as a Heritage Precinct (because of the importance of both Aboriginal and European Industrial heritage), a Boat Ramp Precinct, and a Headland Precinct.

The Boat Harbour Masterplan will inform future improvements and management of the area as funding becomes available.


Loss of historic Nowra Sailing Club building

Council is incredibly disappointed with the loss of the historic Nowra Sailing Club following a fire which destroyed the building on Wednesday evening, 21 June 2017.

The Council building was occupied by the Nowra Sailing Club up until November 2015, but was unoccupied at the time of the fire.

The building was insured and Council has contacted the insurer. The future of the site cannot be determined until an insurance assessment has been undertaken.

Roads and Works Update

Bomaderry - Birriley & North Tarawal St - A road closure is currently in place until Friday, 30 June 2017 (throughout the day and night). The temporary closure is necessary to allow workers to construct the centre island component. <u>Read more...</u>

Bomaderry / Bolong - Bolong Rd - Roadworks have commenced on the widening of Bolong Road in the vicinity of Hanigans Lane. The works will also involve widening east of Jennings Lane following the Hanigans Lane section. The projects are expected to be completed by September 2017.

Nowra - Stewart Place - Construction is now in the open bus interchange area. Kerb and gutter has been relocated. New footpath is under construction. The next stage of the works will be to construct concrete islands which will change the direction that buses will park in the open area.

Ulladulla - South St and Jubilee Ave – The roundabout is now in operation and South Street reopened. Final works include linemarking, some landscaping, and access installation, and are expected to be completed by late June.

Upcoming road works

Callala Bay - Callala Beach Rd - Road pavement reconstruction and road widening will commence early August. The works will be undertaken from Emmett St for 500m to the north.

Callala Bay - Callala Beach Rd and Forest Rd Intersection – Road widening and safety improvements will commence early August. Works include the removal of selected trees on the northern side of the intersection, the construction of a passing lane for East bound traffic and the placement of a 10mm AC surface over the intersection.

Sanctuary Point - Kerry St and Paradise Beach Rd - A roundabout is proposed at the intersection of Kerry Street and Paradise Beach Road. Construction is scheduled to commence in the coming months.

Ulladulla - Deering and Jubilee Sts – A roundabout is proposed at the intersection of Deering and Jubilee Streets. Construction is scheduled to commence in the coming months. Another roundabout is proposed at the

Ulladulla - St. Vincent and Church Sts - A roundabout is proposed at the intersection of St. Vincent and Church Streets. Construction is scheduled to commence in the coming months.
