The name the 'Roy McDaniel Bridge' has been nominated by the community. Roy McDaniel was a Shoalhaven City Councillor for Council from 1995 to 1999. He was a strong advocate for preserving Burrill Lake and campaigned for a new bridge for more than ten years. Mr McDaniel died in 2009.

Roads and Works Update

The following road and asset works are currently being undertaken:

Bangalee Koloona Drive – Work will be undertaken on the bridge over Bangalee Creek, commencing on Thursday, 20 July 2017. Expected completion is on Friday, 21 July. These works will be undertaken under the bridge to strengthen it, enabling the load limit to be increased.

Bundewallah - Bundewallah Road – Strengthening work commenced on the bridge over Chishoms Creek on 24 July 2017. The works are expected to take 1-2 weeks. The road will remain open.

Culburra Beach - Culburra Road – Stage 2 of Road pavement reconstruction and road widening. The extent of works will include the Coonemia Road intersection up to the recently completed stage 1 works. Spray sealing of stage 2 commenced and is scheduled to be completed by Thursday, 20 July, with line marking expected to be completed 28 July 2017.

Nowra Hill - Albatross Road - Full pavement



rehabilitation of approximately 0.69km from Braidwood Road to HMAS Albatross has been completed, and the sprayed bitumen wearing course scheduled for placement due to finish by 22 July 2017. Line marking and lane delineation is scheduled for the week commencing 31 July.
