The logo design is inspired by Nowra, the Aboriginal word for Black Cockatoo. The rebrand was designed in-house through Council. Read more [here](#).

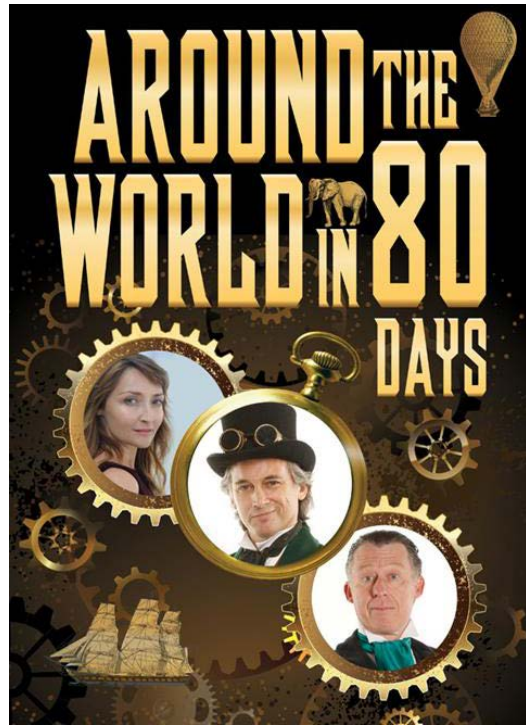
WIN tickets to the play "Around the World in 80 days"

Roads and Works Update

Mollymook: Mollymook Eastern Beachfront Carpark will be temporary closed - The eastern (beachfront) carpark at Mollymook Beach Reserve will be closed from Monday, 7 August 2017 for a period of up to two weeks.

The carpark will be closed to allow repairs to the road and cul-de-sac at the surf club to be completed. This work will block all



Berry: Agars Lane – Shoulder stabilising and localised heavy patching will be carried out along Agars Lane. The work will start from Beach Rd and extend 1.5km of Agars Lane commencing 14 August. Lane closures with delays of up to 10 minutes will apply.

Callala Beach: Callala Beach Road – Road pavement reconstruction and road widening will commence in August. The works will be undertaken from Emmett Street for 500m to the north. Callala Beach Road will be closed from 7 August until the works are complete. A detour will be in place via Emmett St and Callala Bay Road.

Tomerong: Hawken Road – Widening of the eastern road shoulder north of Pine Forest Road intersection will be undertaken in August to allow for an on-road footpath.

Berry District Park Update



At Council's Strategy and Assets meeting held on 18 July 2017, Council adopted the Berry District Park Master Plan Option A. This enables detailed design to commence including the landscape design, land survey, feasibility analysis and delivery plan.

The centrepiece of the Park will be the nature playground. Council will hold further consultations with children, young people and families to better understand how they engage with 'nature play'.
