# Dredging Works at Sussex Inlet and Lake Conjola

Council is seeking feedback on the positive and negative effects of dredging at Sussex Inlet and Lake Conjola. Council undertook dredging works between March and September 2016.

### **Upcoming Works**

Basin View Basin View Pde – New kerb and gutter will be constructed to seven property frontages in August and September.



### **Roads and Works Update**

The following road and asset works are currently being undertaken:

Hyams Beach Silver Strand Circuit - Widening the road shoulder and retaining the road verge along the southern edge of Silver Strand Circuit. Works are being carried out to facilitate parallel parking adjacent the National Park.

Kangaroo Valley Gerringong Creek Road Works will be undertaken on a sealed
section of pavement adjacent to
Gerringong Creek. Please be aware that
due to the narrow road conditions, there
will be delays of up to 15 minutes while
drilling equipment is established.

Sanctuary Point Kerry Street and Paradise
Beach Road – A roundabout is proposed at
the intersection of Kerry Street and
Paradise Beach Road and a contractor has
been awarded. Construction will
commence shortly. This project is being
funded under the Federal Blackspot
Program for 2016/17.

Berrara Myrniong Grove – The construction of the approximately 105m of kerb and guttering between #14 and #22 Myrniong Grove.

Falls Creek Woollamia Road – Piping of an existing open drain across the verge and into an easement across private property near the intersection of Falls Road West will be carried out in September.

Huskisson Intersection of Naval College Road, Huskisson Road and Pine Forest Road - The design and construction of road rehabilitation is due to commence shortly. The contractor has been awarded and it is expected that the project will take approximately six weeks.

Ulladulla St. Vincent and Church Streets – A roundabout is proposed at the intersection of St. Vincent and Church Streets with a design completed and tender phase due to start. Construction is scheduled to commence in the coming months. This project is being funded under the Federal Blackspot Program for 2016/17.

Road and assets projects are regularly updated on Council's <u>website</u>.

All works are subject to weather permitting.

An intergenerational technology troubleshooting project has linked


teenagers from Nowra High School with seniors in the Shoalhaven.

The"Gen Connect" program is a facilitated workshop held weekly on Thursdays from 2pm-3pm during the school term at Nowra Library. The workshop encourages seniors to bring in their smart phones, tablets and laptops and link with a student to assist them in discovering how to use the technology or help with specific issues that they are encountering with their devices.

Sarah Taylor, Manager of Shoalhaven Libraries said, "We have loved running the GenConnect program and have really seen the positive impact that the program has had on the seniors who have attended."

All the participants have stated that the program was very helpful in not only helping them support and solve their technology problems but also in gaining confidence with technology.
