Roads and Works Update

Berry *Agars Lane* – Shoulder stabilising and localised heavy patching will be carried out along Agars Lane from 15 August with expected completion on 31 August. The work will start from Beach Road and extend 1.5km of Agars Lane. Guideposts and pavement markings will be reinstated approximately two weeks after completion of the prime seal. A final seal for this project has not been scheduled. Lane closures with delays of up to 10 minutes will apply.

Bomaderry / Bolong *Bolong Road* - The roadworks on the widening of Bolong Road near Hanigans Lane are continuing. The project is expected to be completed by September 2017.

Tomerong *Hawken Road* – Widening of the eastern road shoulder north of Pine Forest Road intersection will be undertaken in August/September to allow for an “On-Road Footpath”.

Worroughing Heights / Vincentia *Naval College Road* - Limited to between Pine Forest Road and Seagrass Avenue. Works will include road shoulder widening and sealing. The project construction activities are expected to be completed by the end of August 2017.

Recently Completed:- Culburra Beach *Culburra Road* – Stage 2 of Road pavement reconstruction and road widening. A final seal will be conducted during March 2018.

Bird Walks in the Shoalhaven


