



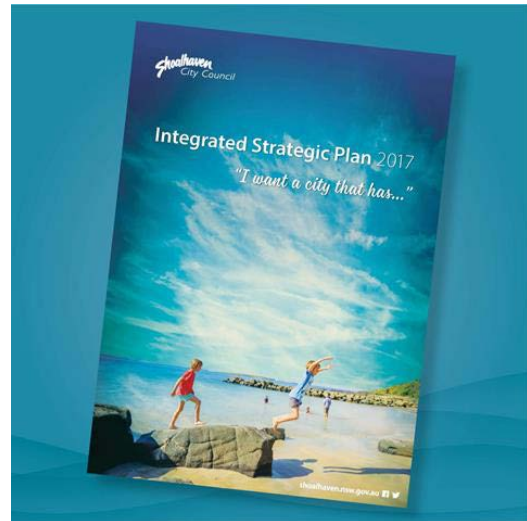

Council has adopted the new Integrated Strategic Plan (ISP) document which incorporates the final Community Strategic Plan, Delivery and Operational Plan, Resourcing Strategy, Fees and Charges and Long Term Financial Plan.

Council to Advocate for Waste Levy Funds



During the August 2017 Strategy and Assets Meeting, Mayor Amanda Findley made a recommendation for Shoalhaven City Council to continue to make representations and advocate to the NSW State Government to return Waste Levy funds to the regions they were collected from.

Mayor Findley suggested that the Shoalhaven City Council should be excluded from the metropolitan levy collection or at the very least, have the levy amount reduced in the Shoalhaven to the same regional level as other regional areas such as the Blue Mountains.

Mayor Findley said it was to the benefit of the Shoalhaven to have more of the Waste

Levy funds return to the regions. "The State Government is extracting from Shoalhaven residents and businesses over \$33 million in the last four years and only returned \$1,735 million, that is only 5.2%?"

Council is currently reviewing the Entrance Management Policy for Tabourie Lake.

In conjunction with the NSW Government, Council is responsible for managing the entrance of Tabourie Lake for the purpose of flood mitigation. The [Tabourie Lake Entrance Management Policy and Review of Environmental Factors](#) documents the procedure for opening the Lake.

Basin View Basin View Parade – New kerb

Callala Beach Callala Beach Road/Forest Road Intersection - Road widening and pavement works at intersection continue and include pavement reconstruction of Callala Beach Road (700m length). Callala Beach Road closed to traffic, detour by Emmett Street. Forest Road is under traffic control during work times. Scheduled for completion at end September.

Conjola Bendalong Road - Council is working on 2km of shoulder widening and pavement reconstruction in the area. Traffic control is in place with works scheduled for completion at the end November. Further pavement rehabilitation is planned for later in the financial year.

Coolangatta Coolangatta Road - Pavement reconstruction is in progress (Bolong Road end). The services relocation is nearing completion with all works due for

and gutter will be constructed to seven property frontages commencing 1 September.

Bomaderry Bolong Road - The current shoulder widening works is nearing completion. Further road improvement projects are planned for later in the financial year. The culvert upgrade at Rotary Park is due to start mid-late September, traffic control to be in place, but open for two way traffic.

Callala Beach Callala Beach Road/Forest Road Intersection - Road widening and pavement works at intersection continue and include pavement reconstruction of Callala Beach Road (700m length). Callala Beach Road closed to traffic, detour by Emmett Street. Forest Road is under traffic control during work times. Scheduled for completion at end September.

Conjola Bendalong Road - Council is working on a 2km of shoulder widening and pavement reconstruction in the area. Traffic control is in place with works scheduled for completion at the end November. Further pavement rehabilitation is planned for later in the financial year.

South Nowra Flinders Road - This is a major project to widen and upgrade to provide 13m wide road with kerb and gutter and improved drainage. Works will continue until Christmas. The road is open with traffic control in place.

Update: Albatross Road, Nowra Hill and Culburra Road, Culburra. These roads only have had an initial seal and a second coat will be applied during the warmer months. The initial seal is susceptible to damage from vehicles, particularly at the intersections. The second seal will resolve these issues.

The proposed road name is Riberry Lane. The new road is being constructed to provide access to properties who will no longer have direct access from the Princes Highway.
