


International Youth Day Awards

Roads and Works Update

Bomaderry/Bolong Bolong Road - Culvert upgrade roadworks adjacent to Rotary Park will begin shortly.

Callala Beach Lennox Road, Griffin Street, Silkwood Walk - Council contractors will be cutting vegetation back from the road verges along Lennox Road, Griffin Street and Silkwood Walk at Callala Beach. The work is part of Council's extensive Bushfire Mitigation Program that sees sites with high bushfire risk treated using burning, slashing, mowing and tree trimming/removal. North Nowra Greys Beach – Installation of construction piles and pontoons at Greys Beach will be carried out in the coming month, with expected completion prior to the Shoalhaven River Festival.

Microchip your cat for free during September

RSPCA NSW is running a cat campaign in September about desexing, microchipping

and containing your cats.

Cat/kitten microchipping is only \$10 during September.

Statistics from 1 January to 31 August at the RSPCA Shelter Shoalhaven state there were 39 stray cats with ID and 274 cats with no ID. Only five were reclaimed.

Only 3% of lost cats are returned to their original homes.

Did you know - In just two years, a pair of undesexed cats can lead to 20,000 kittens.



Desex, Chip, Protect. Microchip your cat for \$10 at the RSPCA until the end of September.

In the interest of animal management and welfare, Council Rangers have a close working relationship with the RSPCA.

Council recognises the good work the RSPCA and the Animal Welfare League do within the community to assist pet owners with subsidised microchipping and desexing.
