The next public meeting will be held on Monday, 13 November 2017 at 7.00pm at the Nowra School of Arts. All welcome, no RSVP required.

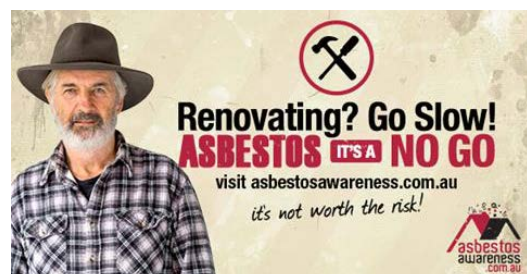

As part of Council's ongoing commitment to preserving and enhancing its road pavement assets, a bitumen road resealing program will be undertaken in the following locations throughout the Shoalhaven commencing Monday, 6 November 2017. Weather permitting, this work will be completed by Monday, 20 November 2017.

After the reseat is completed some loose stone will remain on the road surface. Please drive carefully to minimise loss of tyre traction and stone throwing.

Greenwell Point Road, Brundee - Works will be undertaken at the intersection of Greenwell Point Road and Mayfield Road in order to provide a new stabilised pavement and high friction asphalt surface at the intersection. The works will continue from the recently completed section west of the Mayfield intersection.
