Summer Bus Bay and Basin

Jump aboard the Summer Shuttle Bus this school holidays! Council is enhancing public transport with a temporary Summer Shuttle Bus linking the Bay and Basin area.

Operating from Monday, 18 December 2017 to Friday, 5 January 2018 the bus will allow residents and visitors to easily move around the Bay and Basin for a gold coin donation.

The Summer Bus is supported through Transport NSW Government grant funding and in partnership with Bay and Basin Community Resource Centre, Vincentia High School, Kennedy's Bus and Coach and Shoalhaven Swim and Fitness.

The Bay and Basin Summer Shuttle Bus will be in operation from 9.45am to 2.15pm. The route includes Basin View Shops, St Georges Basin Shops, Sanctuary Point Shops, Old Erowal Bay, Vincentia Marketplace, Bay and Basin Leisure Centre, Vincentia Shops, Owen Street Bus Stop. Roads and Works Update

Callala Beach - Lewis Road, Quarry Road - Full service reseal. Affected residents will be notified by the contractor prior to works being carried out. Please keep the road corridor clear during spray sealing. Preparations for spray sealing are scheduled for completion prior to 15 December 2017.

Goorama Drive - Replacement of sections of kerb and gutter.



Please note that all quoted completion dates are subject to change due to weather conditions, emergencies or other unforeseen interruptions.

Bay & Basin & Central Area - A bitumen road resealing program will be undertaken in the following locations commencing Monday, 27 November 2017 and is scheduled for completion by Friday, 8 December 2017 at: *Basin View:* Boathaven Ave, Harper Road, Harriss Ave, John Street, Mathie Street, Valda Ave. *Woollamia:* Erina Road, Duranbah Drive. *Sassafras:* Braidwood Road *Yerriyong:* Braidwood Road *Tomerong:* Naval College Road, *Worringo Heights:* Naval College Road.

After the reseal is completed, some loose stones may remain on the road surface. Please drive carefully to minimise loss of tyre traction and stone throwing.

Berry - *Intersection Edward & Albert Streets -* Replacement of footpath and installation of kerb ramp will commence shortly.

Bomaderry/Bolong - *Duffys Lane (Bugong Fire Trail) -* The replacement of a timber bridge Bugong Fire Trail, approximately 900m from Duffys Corner, will be undertaken during December 2017 and January 2018. Some disruption to access may occur.

Brundee - *Greenwell Point Road -* Road pavement reconstruction, reshaping and shoulder widening. The works are being undertaken at the intersection of Greenwell Point and Mayfield Roads to provide a new stabilised pavement and high friction asphalt surface at the intersection. During the period 4 November to the 1 December, Greenwell Point Road will be closed to through traffic

Comberton to Wolloombulla - *Forest Road -* Heavy Patching has commenced. Works are being carried out from 6.5km east of the Princes Highway through to Callala Beach Road intersection. Minor delays can be expected. All works are scheduled for completion prior to 15 December 2017.

Culburra - ROAD CLOSURE - Culburra Road – Crookhaven River Bridge aka Archgate Bridge – approximately 1 km West of Coonemia Road intersection. Council road crews will be undertaking essential interim works on the Crookhaven River Bridge on Sunday, 3 December 2017. All works will progress subject to weather conditions on the day. Works will be conducted between 6.00 am to 6.00 pm on the day. This will require motorists travelling to and from Culburra to detour via Coonemia and Forest Road to reach destinations. Closing the road is unavoidable and so we thank motorists in anticipation for their patience.

Currarong - *Cambewarra Road, Crookhaven Parade, Currarong Parkway, Pacific Ave, Piscator Ave, Tomerong Street, Walton Way, Worrigea Road -* Full service reseal. Affected residents will be notified by the contractor prior to works being carried out. Please keep the road corridor clear during spray sealing. Preparations for spray sealing are scheduled for completion prior to 15 December 2017.

Falls Creek and Woollamia - *Woollamia Road -* Heavy patching road repairs will be carried out along Woollamia Road during November and December.

Huskisson - *Huskisson Road -* Heavy patching road repairs will be carried out along Huskisson Road in November.

Jaspers Brush - *Croziers Road -* The replacement of a timber bridge at the end

between Millbank Road and Jindy Andy Lane and vehicles detoured at these locations.

Budgong - Duffys Lane (Bugong Fire Trail) - The replacement of a timber bridge Bugong Fire Trail, approximately 900m from Duffys Corner, will be undertaken during December 2017 and January 2018.

Burrier - Off Burrier Road - The replacement of two timber bridges will be undertaken on the road off Burrier Road over November and December 2017.

Callala Bay - Barden Close, Bay Street, Chapman Street, Fleet Way, Illustrious Court, Marine Parade, Murray Street, Torrens Close, Wearne Street will have a full service road reseal. Affected residents will be notified by the contractor prior to works being carried out. Please keep the road corridor clear during spray sealing. Preparations for spray sealing are scheduled for completion prior to 15 December 2017.

of Croziers Road will be undertaken during November and December 2017. Some disruption to access may occur.

Nowra Hill - BTU Road – Animal Shelter Access Road and Intersection upgrade. The works consist of service relocation, installation of new drainage culverts, widening and sealing of Nowra Hill Road from the intersection of BTU road to the new Animal Shelter entrance. BTU road will also be widened at the intersection, with an asphalt overlay. During the works, traffic lights and/or stop slow traffic control will be in place.
