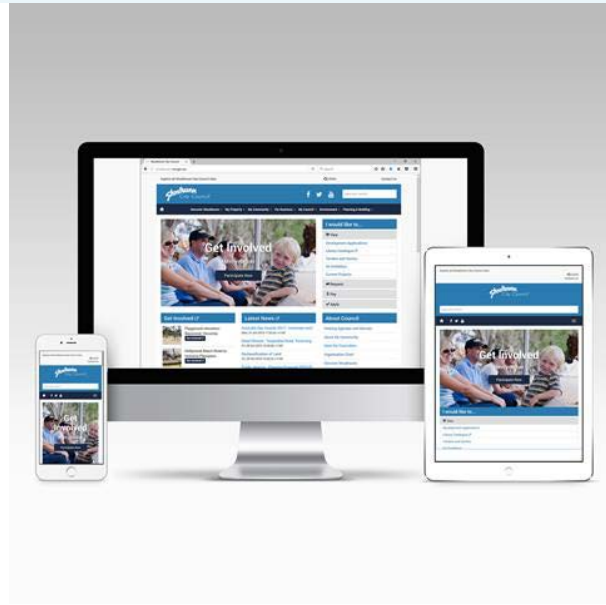




New Communication Tools

Roads and Works Update

The following roads are works are being undertaken:

Coolangatta Road, Coolangatta – Pavement rehabilitation of a 500m section at the Bolong Road end. This is the first of three projects on this road planned in this financial year. The current works are expected to be finished by mid November.

As part of the Turpentine Road upgrade project,

undertaking drainage works in the reserve backing onto properties along Orient Ave, Orontes Street and Ormonde Crescent. The works include installation of an underground drainage system along with surface swales to divert flows away from properties. These augmentation works are designed to alleviate flooding in this area. Works should be completed by end of November.

Flinders Road, South Nowra will be reopening on the 4 November 2016.

Roundabout construction will start at Quinns Lane and Old Southern Road, South Nowra from mid-November 2016. Work is scheduled to be completed by March 2017, weather permitting. The project is necessary to service the future traffic generated by the development in the area.

Council will be carrying out pavement rehabilitation to a 300m section of Turpentine Road starting 200m from the Princes Highway, Tomerong. Construction work is programmed from 7 to 25 November 2016 between 7.00am and 4.00pm (weather permitting) and will be carried out under traffic control except for Monday 7 and Wednesday 9 November when this section will be closed to through traffic to allow profiling and stabilising processes.

Meet new friends and learn more about the local ecology that we live in. Some of the typical activities Bushcare volunteers are involved in are:

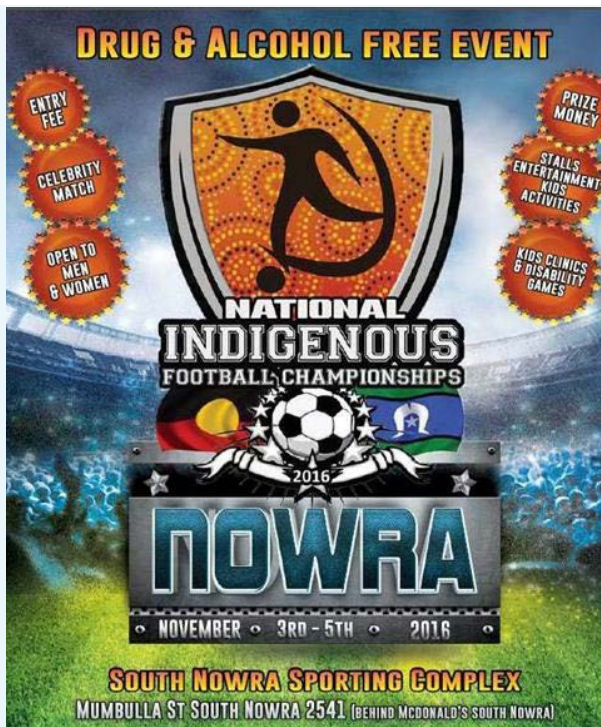
- Bush regeneration/rehabilitation
