#### Roads and Works Update

Flinders Road & Princes Highway, Nowra Intersection Realignment - Minor finishing works and a new slip lane into Rotary Park will be completed over the next few weeks. The majority of works will be undertaken off the road.

Vehicular access to Rotary Park will be blocked during this period. Toilets and other public amenities are available for use at Marriott Park. Actual construction times may vary depending on site and weather conditions encountered.

**Winnima Lane, Huskisson** – Road pavement reconstruction is scheduled to commence shortly, with footpath and streetscape works continuing on adjoining Nowra and Beach Streets. Completion of works is anticipated to be prior to the Christmas break.

**Myola Shared User Path** – Contractors have commenced construction of a 2m wide concrete pathway from Myola Road, along the bushfire track to the existing track to the beach, which connects to Catherine Street.



**Croobyar Road, Milton** – Road repair works are progressing in preparation for resealing in February 2017.

**Ocean Street, Mollymook** – Road works are progressing in preparation for resealing in February 2017.

Road and assets projects are regularly updated on the website.



## Water quality sensor deployed

A second remote water quality sensor has been deployed off-shore from Shoalhaven Heads. The buoy and Aqua-lab sensor were supplied and installed by Australian Laboratory Services for Council, in consultation with Roads and Maritime Services (RMS).

Remote telemetry from the sensors means that real-time water quality data can now be available on Council's Aqua data webpage.
