Berthing Licences – Proposed Marina for Ulladulla Harbour

Shoalhaven City Council is developing a new floating pontoon marina within the existing Ulladulla working harbour infrastructure to facilitate and encourage private, charter and commercial vessels. It is envisaged the marina will be available for occupation early 2018, subject to completion of its construction.

Council is seeking Expressions of Interest (EOI) from persons interested in securing a long term berthing licence, up to 5 years, in the proposed marina.

Berths will be a mixture of 4.0, 4.3, 4.6 & 4.9 widths and ranging in length of 9 and 10 metres. The draft plan can be viewed on Council's website.

EOI can be forwarded by email to council@shoalhaven.nsw.gov.au, writing to PO Box 42, Nowra 2541 or submission on Council's website. Responses are required to outline vessel details, such as power or sail, make, model, length and beam.

ClubGRANTS

ClubGRANTS is a shared State Government-Club Industry program, funded by a 1.85% gaming machine tax rebate provided by the State Government to those registered clubs with gaming machine profits in excess of \$1 million per annum. Registered clubs with annual gaming machine revenue exceeding \$1 million are to apply 0.75% of those funds to Category 1 purposes.

A Local Committee has been formed in the Shoalhaven Local Government area to make recommendations for Category 1 funding.

Community organisations may apply for funding towards local community service needs and priorities from ClubGRANTS.

Examples of projects that may be eligible for Category 1 funding are: Community Welfare Services, Community Development, Community Health Services and Employment Assistance Activities.

Funding applications for programs, projects and services targeting the disadvantaged, assisting people with disabilities, older people, people from non-English speaking backgrounds, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders, women, men and young people are particularly encouraged.
