


Sanctuary Point Library

At this week's Ordinary Meeting, Council determined to construct a District Library at Sanctuary Point, as a matter of priority.

The library had originally been proposed through a draft Masterplan to form part of the future Bay and Basin Community Hub and be located in Vincentia. This draft Masterplan will now be redesigned to remove the library from this location.

Investigations will be undertaken to find a suitable site within Sanctuary Point for the District Library.



Roads and Works Update



Carpark Park Resealing Program

A Bitumen Carpark resealing program is scheduled to commence Tuesday, 3 April and is scheduled for completion by Friday, 13 April 2018.

After the seal is completed some loose stone will remain on the road surface. Please drive carefully to minimise loss of Orient Point - Orama Crescent, Orama
Crescent Service Road, Orsova Parade - Full
service reseals were scheduled to
commence on Tuesday, 3 April. Asphalt
patching will be carried out prior to
resurfacing the pavement which is
scheduled for Monday, 9 April. Spray
sealing will commence after the
preparations are completed. Affected
residents will be notified by the contractor
prior to works being carried out.

Sassafras - Braidwood Road (between Tolwong Road and Bulee Gap Bridge) - Road resealing to commence Tuesday, 3 April and is scheduled for completion by Friday, 6 April 2018. After the seal is completed some loose stone will remain on the road surface. Please drive carefully to minimise loss of tyre traction and stone throwing.

Worrigee - Peppermint Drive, Rayleigh Drive, Kardella Ave, Burradoo Crescent, Mildura Street, Carrington Park Drive, Warrigal Street, Narwee Link, Myall Close and Junee Link. A bitumen road resealing tyre traction and stone throwing.

Culburra - Full service reseals are scheduled to commence week commencing 3 April. Asphalt patching will be carried out from 4 -10 April prior to resurfacing. Spray sealing will commence after the preparations are completed. Please keep the road corridor clear during spray sealing.

Streets in Culburra where reseals will take place include - Tern Street, Jay Street, Flora Street, Prince Edward Ave Service Road, Raglan Street, Sunshine Street, Palm Way, The Mall, The Bowery, Marina Service Road, Woodland Street, Allerton Ave, Park Street, Wollumboola Lane, Carlton Crescent, Cross Street, Greenbank Grove, Ocean Street, Penguins Head Road, Haven Street, Eastbourne Ave, East Crescent and Lee Street

South Nowra - Albatross Road and Flinders Road Roundabouts - The primary roundabout on Albatross Road is open to traffic. The secondary roundabout works linking Albatross Road, Albatross Service Road and Flinders Road have commenced on the southern half. At this stage, completion of the roundabouts will be in May weather permitting.

Kangaroo Valley Hampden Bridge - Roads and Maritime Services will be carrying out repairs to four timber elements on Hampden Bridge Kangaroo Valley with four consecutive night closures of the bridge in mid May. A detour will be put in place for motor vehicles via Macquarie Pass.
