Roads and Works Update

Please note that all quoted completion dates are subject to change due to weather conditions, emergencies or other unforeseen interruptions.

Callala Bay Emmett Street -The existing school crossing will be upgraded with concrete kerb islands and a patterned raised threshold during the April school holidays.

Falls Creek Jervis Bay Road - Widening of road shoulders and extension of guardrail on the first curve south of Woollamia Road intersection will commence late April.

Huskisson Hawke Street - The Gravel sections of footpath adjacent to Whitesands Park will be concreted in May.

Pyree & Greenwell Point Greenwell Point Road – Shoulder grading from Pyree to Greenwell Point.

Vincentia Frederick Street - Carriageway vegetation clearing scheduled for March to address issues affecting high vehicles and buses.

The Wool Road - Footpath grinding scheduled for April to address trip points on walkways and cycle ways. For further information please call 4406 2000

Upcoming Works:

Nowra Junction Street/Princes Highway Traffic Signals - Traffic Signals are proposed for the Princes Highway at Junction Street. The tender will be advertised at the end of March with construction scheduled to start in May.

Moss Street and Shoalhaven Street - Footpath replacement.

Ulladulla Green Street - Safety Around
Schools Raised Pedestrian Threshold. The
construction of a raised concrete
pedestrian threshold will be located at the
site of the existing children's crossing on
Green Street. Works will take place during
the Easter School Holidays.

Vincent Street and Twyford Street –
Continuation of the shared path will be carried out June.

Sanctuary Point Tahnee & Nadine Streets

Corner - A section of road pavement and
failed kerb and gutter will be replaced in

April / May. A minor detour will be in place
for approximately two weeks.

Hawken Road - The existing school crossing will be upgraded with a patterned raised threshold during the April school holidays.

Worrowing Heights Naval College Road - The bridge over Moona Moona Creek on Naval College Road is to be replaced with construction to start in the next couple of months. Design has been completed and tender documentation is underway. Dates will be updated after tender has been awarded.




