Anzac Day Marches

The following ANZAC Day services will be held in the Shoalhaven:

- **Berry** - 10.30am - March through Queen Street Berry. Assemble in Queen Street at 10.15am then move at 10.45am to the Memorial Service at Memorial Park, Berry.
- **Bomaderry** - 5.45am - Dawn Service at Walsh Memorial Park followed at 9.15am with the march. Assemble at Bomaderry RSL at 9am for the service at Walsh Memorial Park.
- **Callala Beach** - 10am - Memorial Service, Cenotaph at Callala RSL Country Club.
- **Currarong** - 9:50am - March commences. Assemble at the fire shed at 9.30am. Followed at 10:00am by a Memorial Service at Currarong Bowling Club.
- **Culburra Beach** - 11.45am for the March. Assemble at Culburra Bowling Club at 11.30am. Followed at noon with a service at the War Memorial.
- **Greenwell Point** - 5.30am Dawn Service, ANZAC Park. Assemble at the Memorial Hall at 5.10am.
- **Huskisson** - 10:30am Assemble at Hawke Street near White Sands Park followed by 11am Memorial Service at Voyager Park.
- **Kangaroo Valley** - 10.00am Assemble at Osborne Park Showground at 9:45am for the Service at the War Memorial.

Crookhaven River Bridge

Council has accepted grant funding for the upgrade of the Crookhaven River Bridge (Archgate Bridge) to renew the ageing piece of infrastructure.

Mayor Amanda Findley said the upgrades will improve the strength of the bridge which has seen a significant deterioration and supports a main arterial road in the Shoalhaven.

\$397,000 from Council's Bridge Renewal Program will be supporting the \$396,000 Australian Government grant funding for the project.

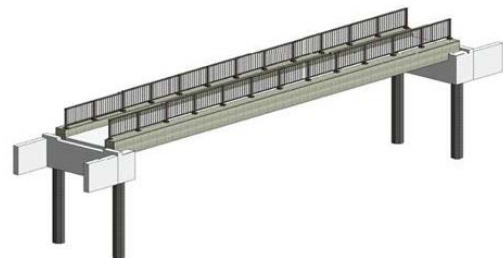

Moona Moona Creek Shared User Path Bridge

Works on the Moona Moona Creek Shared User Path Bridge will commence in the coming week and are set to improve pedestrian and cycling access and safety across the popular holiday spot.

The new shared user path bridge will be a completely separate bridge, to the east of the existing road bridge and will also feature a viewing platform on the north-eastern side.

Roadworks

Conjola - Bendalong Road - Road rehabilitation and widening over 1.1kms, commencing 1.6kms from the intersection of the Princes Highway. Works have commenced and are scheduled to be completed mid May 2018. The road will be reduced to one lane and traffic lights will be in operation during the works. Motorists will experience short delays.

Pyree - Greenwell Point Road - Road rehabilitation and widening over 450m, commencing 130m East of Pyree Lane. Works have commenced and scheduled to undertaken up to 1 June 2018. Traffic control will be used during the works. Motorists will experience short delays of up to 10 minutes.

Sassafras - Braidwood Road (between Tolwong Road and Bulee Gap Bridge) - Road resealing is complete. After the seal is completed some loose stone will remain on the road surface. Linemarking is scheduled for completion by the end of April 2018.

Currarong - Currarong Road - Road resealing is complete. After the seal is completed some

loose stone will remain on the road surface.
Linemarking is scheduled for completion by
the end of April 2018.
