Council has welcomed Prime Minister Malcolm Turnbull's \$155 million commitment to funding the Nowra Bridge under the federal government's budget announcement.



## Currambene Creek Precautionary Advice

The NSW Government has released precautionary dietary advice for six fish species caught in the Currambene Creek. This advice has been released following fish sampling conducted by the Commonwealth Department of Defence (Defence) as part of

their investigation into PFAS from HMAS Albatross, which found levels of PFAS in these six species.

The advice will guide recreational fishers who frequently consume Eastern Sea Garfish, Estuary Perch, Luderick, Mulloway, Sea Mullet and Silver Trevally from Currambene Creek to safely manage their personal intake of these fish.

The initial works will be related to the approach paths on either side of the proposed new bridge, and preparation for installing the piles for the abutments. The

# Roadworks and Infrastructure

**Sussex Inlet, Jacobs Drive** - Streetscape works with minor inconvenience to traffic and parking expected.

**Ulladulla, Deering Street** – Shared User Pathway Stage 1, the construction of approximately 340m of concrete pathway 2.5m wide. Works will commence at the Ulladulla Soccer Fields and continue towards the Lighthouse for approx. 340m.

**Vincentia, Naval College Road** (Eastern End) - grass strip between the kerb and gutter and concrete footpath is being infilled with concrete.

actual placement of the bridge components is expected to be carried out in June. Traffic controls will be in place during the works including a lane closure with traffic lights used to control traffic flow. Delays should be expected.

**Morton/Woodburn, Wheelbarrow Road** – 1.22 kms of Wheelbarrow Road at Morton/Woodburn is scheduled to be resealed with new shoulders, signage and guideposts installed. The tender for this project closed on the 31st May with an expected start of construction in July. This project is funded under the Federal Black Spot program.
